

SAFETY BLUEPRINT

HANDY HAND OUT – BUILD A SAFETY PLAN – LADDER SAFETY

- ✓ GET THE RIGHT SIZED LADDER FOR THE JOB
 - CHOOSE 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14 and 16 feet
 - BE CAREFUL WITH SMALL STEP LADDERS SERVING AS TRIP HAZARDS

- ✓ EXTENSION LADDER SAFETY
 - 12-36 FOOT LADDER
 - DON'T LEAN THE LADDER TO CLOSE OR TOO FAR
 - TEST BY EXTENDING ARMS TO BE SURE YOU CAN REACH THE RUNG
 - TIE THE LADDER OFF ON EACH SIDE
 - MAKE SURE THE WALL IS SECURE

- ✓ MISC TIPS
 - LADDERS THAT FOLD IN 4 PLACES IS NOT GOOD FOR HEAVY WORK
 - MAKE SURE JOINTS AREN'T RUSTED
 - WEAR A TOOL BELT TO KEEP HANDS FREE

- ✓ MOST IMPORTANT TIPS
 - DON'T USE RANDOM OBJECTS AS LADDERS
 - SET AN EXAMPLE FOR OTHERS
 - DON'T LEAVE TOOLS ON TOP OF THE LADDER
